The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2020 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for LAMB COUNTY from the same properties in both the 2019 tax year and the 2020 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that LAMB COUNTY may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that LAMB COUNTY is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2020 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 14, 2020 at 10:15 AM at Lamb County Courtroom.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, LAMB COUNTY is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting Commissioners Court of LAMB COUNTY at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
