Lighting of Christmas Tree December 2nd.

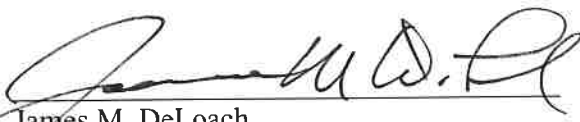
Christmas parade on December 6th and sock drive at the Lamb County Library.
