Future agenda items;

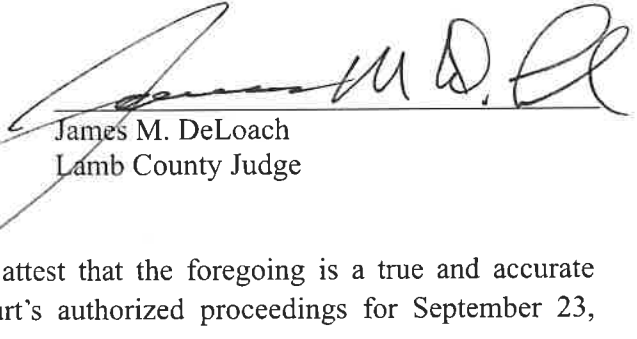
