



Brandon Albus , County Extension Agent introduced the new Agronomist, Christy Keys and she gave a report on projects that going on in four counties.


Brandon Albus also gave a report detailing the Lamb County kids projects and activities over the past weekend.

**ORDER NO.6:**


Adjournment;
